

Susan Windley-Daoust, Director of Missionary Discipleship, is establishing a **Discipleship Quad** throughout the diocese. These are very small groups of four men or four women who agree to meet regularly for around a year to grow in discipleship together and challenge each other to a closer walk with Christ. The booklet with materials and what to discuss and how is free online. You can do this in a Church, a coffeehouse, your home, or Zoom. You need to provide the time and maybe the coffee.

What makes Discipleship Quads different from every other small group is that participants are strongly encouraged to consider running their own discipleship quad the year following the initial group, with three different people. You're paying it forward, basically. And that is how the multiplication happens. Because spending a year with three others reading scripture together, praying together, faith sharing together—it will impact your faith life in positive ways. Inviting God in deliberately always does! It is worth sharing!

If we had 20 people in the diocese participate in this year—and they all multiplied it forward the next year, there would be 80 deeper disciples. If kept going, roughly, by year ten 174,960!!!! Of course people will have to drop out because of illness, or life issues. But even cut that in half and we have a stronger, more peaceful, more joy-filled people of God ready to be Christ's hands and feet in a challenging world...and attractive to those outside the Church wondering what we are really all about.
