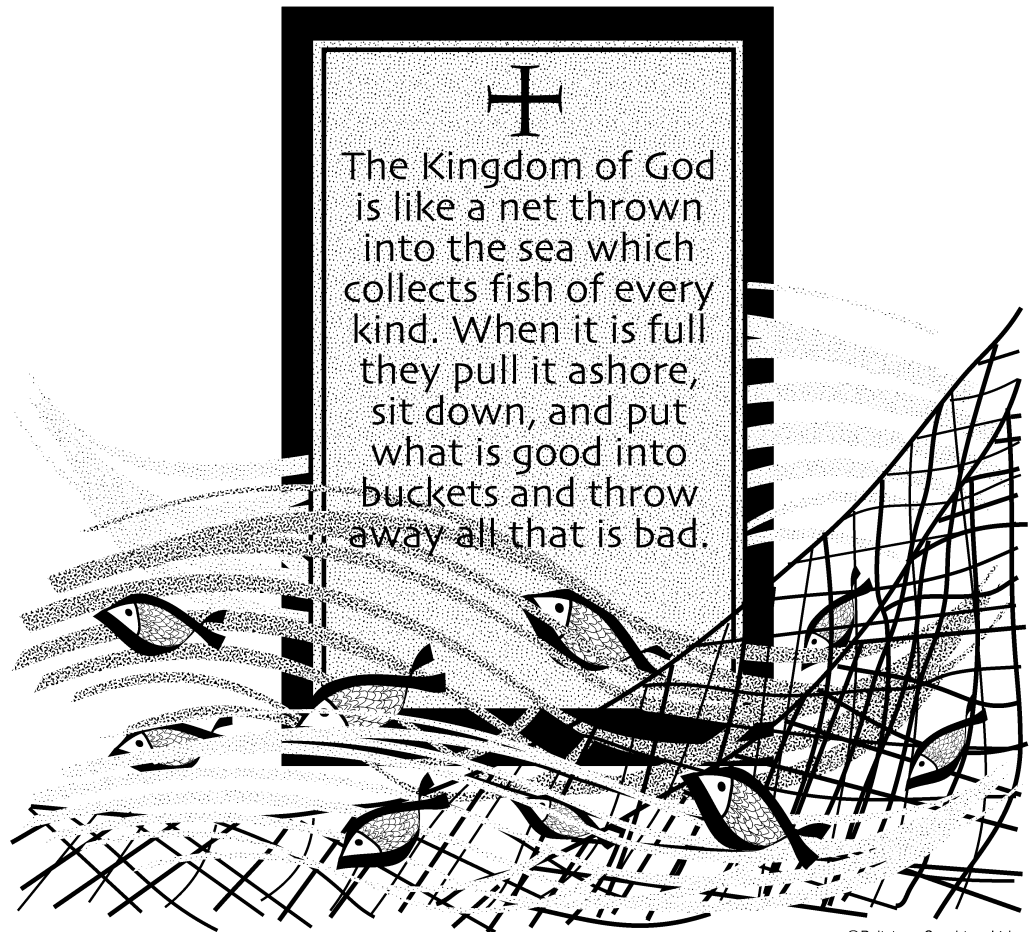

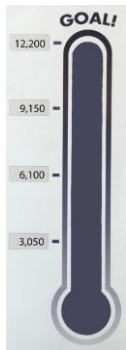

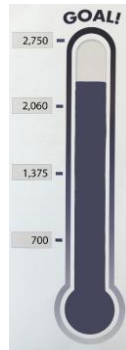

I've been thinking lately a bit about Lazarus. Imagine that: dying, burial, and then...you're alive again! Well, maybe that's what every morning feels like before coffee. At any rate, Lazarus was given a new life. He would die again, but life from that point forward would be different. In some ways, that's what life with a new pastor probably feels like, especially in these strange times.

First, I want to thank the seminary priests for covering for me during my studies. I know they enjoyed their time at our parishes! Second, I want to share a little bit about how this "new life" will be with me as your pastor.

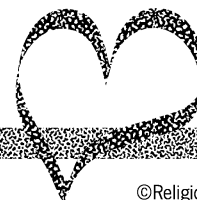
Like Fr. Frerichs, I am splitting time between the parishes and the Diocese. Unlike Fr. Frerichs, my schedule will require more flexibility. I plan to be in the parishes on Wednesdays, Thursday and Friday mornings, and the weekends. I still have to see how evening activities/meetings will play out. However, there will be times, even on short notice, when I may have to reschedule appointments or cancel daily Masses. I will do my best to communicate any changes as quickly and clearly as possible.

Sacramentally, I will make a few changes effective August 1. Daily Mass will resume, but only on Wednesday and Thursday in Lewiston, and Friday in Altura. The weekend Mass schedule will remain the same, but I will not be regularly available for Confessions before Mass. Instead, I will be available for Confessions on Fridays from 5-6pm in Lewiston, and by appointment. Due to precautions, Confessions on Fridays will take place outside between the church and cemetery. If there is any precipitation, or when the temperature drops, I will move indoors to the sacristy.

We will find a way to make this new life work!
