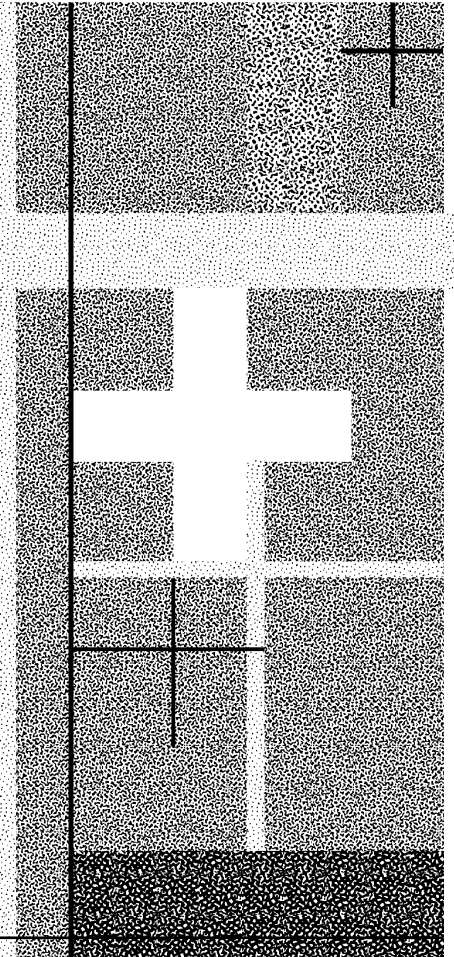

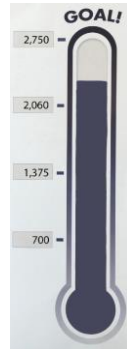

Pastor's Perspective: Where Two or Three (or Four?) are Gathered

Jesus reminds us: "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them." This reference encourages us to community. While I can experience the presence of God on my own, with a "private" faith, it is in community when the presence of Christ is made known. This is one of the primary reasons that we gather for Mass. It is equally true for group prayer and other faith activities. I would like to offer two particular activities for your consideration.

The first is spousal prayer. When was the last time you prayed with your spouse? For some, it was this morning, for others, perhaps much longer, if at all. Spousal prayer is simple, sit down with your spouse in a setting where you can be still and undisturbed for 10-15 minutes (easier said than done for many!). Take time for prayers of thanksgiving and petition, prayers for guidance and protection. Do not use this time to pray for change in your spouse! God doesn't seem to hear that prayer too often, but God does seem to hear the prayer that I would change. It may feel awkward at first, but give it some time. The family, the spouses, that pray together stay together!

Another opportunity I encourage you to consider is something called "Discipleship Quads." Discipleship Quads are structured, weekly gatherings with four people. It begins with a check-in to see how the last week has gone, and then moves into prayer and study materials. You decide the day and time to meet. It can be done in person or online. This opportunity does ask for a one-year commitment, but hey, what else are you going to do this year! If you have ever thought that you would like to grow in your faith, this is a great opportunity. If you put together a group of four, I will make sure you get the guidance you need.

One of the reasons Jesus identifies "two or three" is the reality of how difficult it can be to grow in faith alone. We easily become discouraged or sidetracked. When we have another person—a spouse, friend, or colleague—we gain support and encouragement. Isn't that something we all need?
